

▶ **Automated Red Light Enforcement (ARLE) Grant Program**

Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT)

Approximately \$14 million is available through ARLE for eligible projects, including, but not limited to, traffic control signal improvements; roadway capacity, mobility, and safety upgrades; bicycle and pedestrian improvements; and the implementation of recommendations from the Local Technical Assistance Program (LTAP) Walkable Communities Program and Local Safe Roads Communities Program.

- Eligibility: Municipalities, planning organizations, Commonwealth agencies
- Award Amount: No minimum or maximum stated
- Required Match: None required
- Applications Due: **July 1, 2019**

▶ **North American Wetlands Conservation Act (NAWCA) – U.S. Standard Grants Program**

U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service (USFWS)

The U.S. Standard Grants Program supports public-private partnerships carrying out projects involving long-term protection, restoration, and/or enhancement of wetlands and associated uplands habitats. Applicants are encouraged to partner with other organizations and individuals.

- Eligibility: Public-private partners
- Award Amount: \$100,000 to \$1 million
- Required Match: 50% minimum
- Applications Due: **July 3, 2019**

▶ **PA Water Trails Mini-Grant Program**

Pennsylvania Environmental Council (PEC)

Funding is available for projects that benefit Pennsylvania’s water trails, support the PA Water Trail Program’s [eight program principles](#), and have a one-year timeframe. Any project on or for a [designated Pennsylvania Water Trail](#) is eligible.

- Eligibility: Nonprofits
- Award Amount: Up to \$5,000
- Required Match: 50% minimum
- Applications Due: **July 19, 2019**

▶ **Our Town Grant Program**

National Endowment for the Arts (NEA)

The Our Town Grant Program funds projects that foster a stronger community identity and encourage economic development. Eligible projects may involve arts engagement, cultural planning, and design of cultural and public spaces such as parks, landscapes, bridges, and infrastructure.

- Eligibility: Municipalities, together with a nonprofit arts and design organization
- Award Amount: \$25,000 to \$200,000
- Required Match: 50% minimum
- Webinar: June 24, 2019 @ 3:00pm ([link](#))
- Applications Due: **August 8, 2019**

▶ **Dauphin County Local Share Municipal Grant Program**

*Dauphin County Department of Community & Economic Development/
Dauphin County Gaming Advisory Board*

The Dauphin County Local Share Municipal Grant Program provides funding for infrastructure, health, safety, transportation, and public interest projects in Dauphin County. Eligible applicants include Dauphin County, East Hanover Township, municipalities contiguous with East Hanover Township, and other Dauphin County municipalities if an eligible applicant sponsors them. Potential applicants seeking sponsorship from Dauphin County must submit their sponsorship request by August 1, 2019.

- Eligibility: See above
- Award Amount: No minimum or maximum stated
- Required Match: None required
- Applications Due: **September 3, 2019**
