

SECTION 319 NONPOINT SOURCE MANAGEMENT GRANT

U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)

Funds are available to develop and implement nonpoint source pollution plans and activities in Pennsylvania's Watershed Implementation Plan (WIP) watersheds. Eligible applications include incorporated watershed associations, counties, municipalities, county conservation districts, council of governments, and other authorized listed organizations.

Eligibility:	See above
Award Amount:	No minimum or maximum stated
Required Match:	None required, any match provided will increase competitiveness of application.
Applications Due:	August 9, 2019

PENNSYLVANIA INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (PIDA)

Pennsylvania Department of Community & Economic Development (DCED)

PIDA provides low-interest loans and lines of credit to Pennsylvania businesses that commit to creating and retaining full-time jobs within the commonwealth, as well as for the development of industrial parks and multi-tenant facilities. Loan applications are packaged and underwritten by a network of certified economic development organizations (CEDOs) that partner with PIDA.

Eligibility:	Varied industry sectors, see guidelines
Award Amount:	Varies based on the type of business being financed, see guidelines
Required Match:	50% (generally)
Applications Due:	Rolling Deadline

PENNVEST MULTIFUNCTIONAL RIPARIAN FOREST BUFFER GRANTS

Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (PA DCNR) and Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority (PENNVEST)

PA DCNR and PENNVEST are prequalifying applicants for multifunctional riparian buffer grants. Grant funds can be used for materials and/or services related to the site preparation, buffer installation, and buffer establishment. Only multifunctional buffers are eligible.

Eligibility:	Any government agency, non-governmental organization, private business, and/or Pennsylvania resident
Award Amount:	No minimum or maximum stated
Required Match:	None required
Prequalification Process Ends:	August 31, 2019

Grant application period runs August 1 through September 30, 2019, for prequalified applicants only.
