Funds are available to communities for developing active transportation and land use plans and policies that will improve walking, bicycling, wheeling, and transit connections to everyday destinations and increase safe and accessible opportunities for residents to be physically active.

- Eligibility:** Boroughs, Townships, Cities, Counties, and Metropolitan and Rural Planning Organizations
- Award Amount:** \$10,000 to \$20,000 for development of active transportation plans  
\$3,000 to \$5,000 to assist with development of Complete Streets and/or Vision Zero policies
- Required Match:** None required

## North American Wetlands Conservation Act (NAWCA) - U.S. Standard Grant Program

U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service (USFWS)

The U.S. Standard Grants Program supports public-private partnerships carrying out projects involving long-term protection, restoration, and/or enhancement of wetlands and associated uplands habitats. Applicants are encouraged to partner with other organizations and individuals.

- Eligibility:** Public-private partners
- Award Amount:** \$100,000 to \$1 million
- Required Match:** See [2020 Eligibility Criteria & Processes](#)
- Applications Due:** July 10, 2020

System for Award Management (SAM)  
Account?

*Get ahead of the game and register now!*

In order to apply for federal grants, cooperative agreements, or other forms of federal financial assistance through grants.gov, applicants must be registered and active in the System for Award Management **before** you can submit an application. This process may take up to four or six weeks. Oftentimes grant opportunities are released with a lead time of two months, sometimes less. So, now is the time to apply and be ready when the right funding opportunity comes out.
