## Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program (RACP)

Pennsylvania Office of the Budget

Funds are available for projects included in a Capital Budget Project Itemization Act that have a cultural, civic, historical, regional, or multi-jurisdictional impact and generate substantial increases in employment, tax revenues, or other measures of economic activity.

## Community Facilities Direct Loan & Grant Program

A combination of low-interest, direct loans and grants is available to purchase, construct, and/or improve essential community facilities in rural areas. Examples of essential community facilities include healthcare, public (including street improvements), and public safety service facilities (such as fire stations, police stations, police vehicles, fire trucks, and public works vehicles or equipment).
