TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE MANAGEMENT

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) mandates that any bridge carrying traffic on public roads greater than or equal to 20 feet in span length be inspected at least every other year. However, municipal bridge owners are not mandated to inspect structures less than 20 feet in span length.

RETTEW has been helping municipal bridge owners inventory and assess the condition of their less than 20-foot structures for decades, and we realize a full National Bridge Inspection Standards (NBIS)-level inspection is costly and unnecessary.

RETTEW also develops municipal-wide Bridge Capital Improvement Plans (BCIP), prioritizing bridge needs and creating a budgeting roadmap for the next 20 years.
