

## Small Business Advantage Grant Program

Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PA DEP)

This program provides funding for Pennsylvania small businesses to invest in pollution prevention measures, install energy-efficiency equipment, or implement natural resource protection projects.

<b>Eligibility:</b>	Pennsylvania farmers and small businesses with less than 100 or fewer full-time employees
<b>Award Amount:</b>	\$7,000 maximum
<b>Required Match:</b>	50 percent
<b>Applications Due:</b>	<i>Rolling deadline (until funds are exhausted)</i>

## Boating Facility Grant Program

Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission (PFBC)

Funds are available to help local governments and eligible nonprofit groups provide or improve public recreational boat access facilities in their communities that are open and available for general public use. Funds can be used for the planning, acquisition, development, expansion, and rehabilitation of public boating facilities on the waters of the commonwealth.

<b>Eligibility:</b>	Public entities, including townships, boroughs, municipal and county governments, and nonprofit groups
<b>Award Amount:</b>	None stated
<b>Required Match:</b>	50 percent
<b>Applications Due:</b>	<i>December 30, 2020</i>

## Community Facilities Direct Loan & Grant Program

U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Rural Development

This program provides affordable funding to develop essential community facilities in rural areas. Funds can be used to purchase, construct, and/or improve essential community facilities, to purchase equipment, and to pay related project expenses.

<b>Eligibility:</b>	Public bodies, community-based nonprofit corporations, and Federally recognized tribes
<b>Award Amount:</b>	None stated
<b>Required Match:</b>	None stated
<b>Applications Due:</b>	<i>Rolling deadline</i>
