

FY 2022 Innovative Nutrient and Sediment Reduction (INSR) Program National Fish and Wildlife Foundation (NFWF)

Funds are available for water quality improvement projects or practices that help restore water quality and habitats of the Chesapeake Bay Watershed and its tributary rivers and streams. This program funds projects that demonstrate reductions of nutrient and sediment pollution, involve the growth and enhancement of existing regional-scale partnerships working on watershed restoration, and measurably accelerate the geographic scale and/or rate of implementation for priority water quality improvement practices.

- Award Amount:** Anticipated total funding allocation of \$7 to \$10 million, awards ranging from \$500,000 to \$1 million each
- Required Match:** None stated
- Applications Due:** *Monday, November 15, 2021*
- Final Proposals Due:** *Monday, November 29, 2021 by 11:59 p.m.*

FY 2022 Brownfields Multipurpose, Assessment, and Cleanup Grant Funding U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)

Funds offered through this program may be used to address sites contaminated by hazardous substances, pollutants, or contaminants and petroleum.

- Award Amount:** Varies per grant type
- Required Match:** Varies per grant type
- Applications Due:** *Wednesday, December 1, 2021*

Green Light-Go: Pennsylvania's Municipal Signal Partnership Program Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT)

Funds are available to municipalities and metropolitan or rural planning organizations for projects that improve the efficiency and operation of existing traffic control signals along critical and designated corridors on state highways.

- Award Amount:** Anticipated total funding allocation of \$40 million
- Required Match:** 20 percent
- Applications Due:** *Friday, January 14, 2022*

TREASURY CHANGES DEADLINES FOR AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN (ARP) REPORTS

We received notice from the Pennsylvania State Association of Township Supervisors (PSATS) that the U.S. Department of the Treasury changed the deadline for filing the annual American Rescue Plan report.

“For municipalities with populations under 50,000, also known as non-entitlement units of government (NEUs), the Project and Expenditure Report will now be due on April 30, 2022, and will cover the period between award date and March 31, 2022. This is a change from the previously communicated October 31, 2021, due date for the NEU Project and Expenditure Report.”
