Chesapeake Bay Green Streets, Green Jobs, Green Towns (G3) Grant *U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region III, West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection, and the Chesapeake Bay Trust*

The goal of this [program](#) is to help communities develop and implement plans that reduce stormwater runoff, increase the number and amount of green spaces in urban areas, improve the health of local waters and the Chesapeake Bay, and enhance quality of life and community livability. Offering six project tracks, the G3 grant program is open to local governments, such as municipalities, nonprofit organizations, neighborhood/community associations, and other nonprofit entities with project locations in the [specified area](#).

Community Conservation Partnership Program (C2P2) *Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources*

[C2P2 grants](#) provide funding for projects related to parks, recreation, and conservation. [Eligible entities](#) include municipalities, municipal agencies/authorities, conservation districts, school districts, colleges/universities, nonprofit organizations, designated heritage areas, prequalified land trusts, and state agencies. For-profit, taxed businesses with a primary physical location in the commonwealth that have 100 or fewer full-time equivalent employees are eligible.
