2023 Environmental Grant Program American Water

This [grant program](#), established in 2005, provides funding for “innovative, community-based environmental projects that improve, restore or protect the watersheds, surface water and groundwater supplies.” Eligible projects must be located in an American Water service area. Examples of eligible project activities and outcomes include watershed cleanup, reforestation efforts, streamside buffer restoration, hazardous waste collection, or surface or groundwater protection education. The completed [grant application](#) and materials, including the [Budget Summary Worksheet](#), should be sent to your state’s local coordinator.

Award Amount: \$10,000 maximum
Required Match: N/A
Applications Due: *Must be emailed or postmarked by March 31, 2023*

Chesapeake Bay Stewardship Fund

National Fish and Wildlife Foundation (NFWF), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, and the Chesapeake Bay Program

NFWF is offering funding through the [Chesapeake Bay Stewardship Fund](#) for its [Small Watershed Grants \(SWG\)](#) and [Chesapeake Watershed Investments for Landscape Defense Grants \(WILD\)](#) Programs. Eligible projects for the [SWG Program](#) promote voluntary, community-based efforts to protect and restore the habitats of the Chesapeake Bay and its tributary rivers and streams. Projects eligible for the [WILD Program](#) conserve, steward, and enhance fish and wildlife habitats and related conservation values in the Chesapeake Bay Watershed. Applicants should review the [CBSF Quick Reference Guide](#) to compare and evaluate the programs.

Required Match: Varies by program

The goal of the [G3](#), which offers six project tracks, is to help communities develop and implement plans that reduce stormwater runoff, improve the health of local waters and the Chesapeake Bay, and enhance quality of life and community livability.

Required Match: Match is encouraged, but not required
Applications Due: *March 8, 2023, by 4:00 PM*

Community Conservation Partnership Program (C2P2) Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources

[C2P2 grants](#) provide eligible entities with funding for projects related to parks, recreation, and conservation. Funding is available for a variety of project types.

Award Amount: Varies
Required Match: Varies, but many require at least 50%
Applications Due: *April 5, 2023, by 4:00 PM*
